

Currently, 70.9% of the 32,517 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 24.0%, renter occupied; and 5.1% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.4% are renter occupied; and 11.6% are vacant. In 2010, there were 31,518 housing units in the area - 71.8% owner occupied, 20.4% renter occupied, and 7.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 1.40%. Median home value in the area is \$189,445, compared to a median home value of \$190,791 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 3.10% annually to \$220,676.
