

**GFI Realty Services LLC is pleased to present the exclusive offering of 1043 50th Street (aka 4923 Ft. Hamilton Pkwy)**, a corner (3)-story walk-up apartment building located in the Borough Park section of Brooklyn. The property is ideally situated on the northeast corner of 50th Street and Ft Hamilton Parkway. This prewar asset was constructed in 1931 and totals 6,006 square-feet; it is comprised of six units, one of which is currently vacant, and storage in the basement. There are approximately 10,000 square-feet of air rights available. The property has the potential to be redeveloped into a 15,000 square-feet medical office building at a highly visible intersection.

The apartments are configured as one (1)-bedroom unit, four (2)-bedroom units and one (3)-bedroom unit. Five of the six apartments were gut renovated; completed with laundry connection and hardwood floors. The building wide systems are in excellent condition and the electrical systems have recently been upgraded.

The asset is located on a prime corner in Borough Park, at the intersection of 50th Street and Ft. Hamilton Parkway. Maimonides Medical Center is half a block away from the property on Ft. Hamilton Parkway. Additionally, Ft. Hamilton Parkway provides residents with numerous eateries and local shops. The property is in proximity to New Utrecht Avenue and 13th Avenue, two major commercial corridors lined with countless local and national businesses as well as institutions including Citibank, USPS, Children's Place, Rite Aid and Chase Bank.

Borough Park is a neighborhood in the southwestern part of the borough of Brooklyn, in New York City, United States. The neighborhood covers an extensive grid of streets between Bensonhurst to the south, Bay Ridge to the southwest, Sunset Park to the west, Kensington to the northeast, Flatbush to the east, and Midwood to the southeast. Bounded by Fort Hamilton Parkway to the west, 60th Street to the south, McDonald Avenue and Bay Parkway to the east, and McDonald Avenue to the north, the neighborhood is home to more than 300 religious institutions. The majority of the properties in the area are single family semi-detached homes with some low-rise multifamily mixed into the landscape. Borough Park is served by the F and D trains; it is about 30 minutes from Midtown Manhattan. Bus lines include the 16, which runs along 13th and 14th Avenues, and the 11, which runs along 49th and 50th Streets.


Total Annual Income










## transit map
